Online visits conducted live for lower and upper secondary schools and university by tourist guides or professors who will hold their “in remote” lesson from Villa Farnesina, for an hour and a half. This is the offer and the contribution that the Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei, of which Villa Farnesina is the representative office, but also a museum and place of exhibitions, intends to offer within the field of distance learning to approach the schools.

It will be possible to book an extraordinary online visit of the Villa and of the exhibition "Raphael in Villa Farnesina: Galatea and Psyche"

The Villa, closed as every museums due to the current pandemic, will be extraordinarily open for the contact person of the online visit / lesson who will have to carry a tablet / smartphone and obviously a protective mask.

The digital activities will be available for free both at school and at home through the platforms used by the institutions they belong to.

At the end of each visit or lesson (15-20 minutes), upon request, it will be possible to ask questions online to the curators and researchers team of the exhibition "Raphael in Villa Farnesina: Galatea and Psyche".
